

EXTEND BURLAP UP PAST  
SISAL TWINE TO PROTECT  
TRUNK FROM RUBBING.  
REMOVE AFTER PLANTING.

NOTES:

- SHEETS OF BURLAP ARE CUT TO FIT ROOT BALL. BURLAP IS SECURED IN PLACE WITH TWINE AND PINNING NAILS.
- USE OF SYNTHETIC BURLAP AND TWINE IS PROHIBITED.
- CUT OFF EXTRA TWINE AFTER TYING. DO NOT BUNCH EXCESS UNDER DRUM LACING.
- FIELD FENCE (HOG WIRE) IS SOMETIMES PUT AROUND SIDES OF ROOT BALL FOR ADDITIONAL SUPPORT. FIELD FENCE IS CRIMPED TO MAKE IT TIGHT.



DRUM LACING TWINE TO  
EXTEND FROM EDGE OF  
BALL TO TRUNK AND  
AROUND AT A MINIMUM  
OF 60° TO RETIE, BUT  
NOT WRAPPED  
COMPLETELY AROUND  
TRUNK.

USE UNTREATED  
NATURAL OR TREATED  
SISAL TWINE OF 3-PLY  
OR LESS.
