Illinois Certified Nursery (ICN) Professional Re-Certification Guidelines

Annual re-certification is based on the accumulation of continuing education points and remittance of the required annual fee. Upon submitting the form with your CE points and the \$30 fee to the IGIA office, your designation will be renewed. You will receive a reminder of this re-certification process one month prior to the December 31 expiration annually.



Record Keeping

You are responsible for keeping track of your points. Suitable documentation should be submitted with this form (i.e. name badge from event, copy of registration form, program booklet, etc.). Do not send materials prior to annual re-certification time.

Continuing Education (CE) Points

Four (4) points are required annually. At least two (2) must be obtained through <u>educational</u> horticulture-related programs.

If you are unable to get your points, you may obtain re-certification by re-taking and passing the ICN Pro test. Exceptions may be granted on a case-by-case basis.
